

2019/20 IP Player Development

Starting this September and running through to the end of December, SMHA and NKMH will be providing professional skill development to all Initiation Program Players (IP), both at the IP Timbit Level (under 6) and the IP Local League Level (6 year old's). Once each week, on-ice skill development will be provided by professional third party instructors. All registered IP players will have a chance to develop and grow in our fun filled IP development program, with Free Development Clinics offered on the weekends. No sign up is required.



Supplemental IP Development Program

Due to last year's success, in addition to the regular "free" IP Development Clinics offered to all IP Players detailed above from September-December, King Township Minor Hockey in conjunction with SMHA and NKMH will continue to offer the Supplemental IP Development Program starting Saturday Sept 7th. This optional fee based program will be made up of selected 2013 born players currently registered in SMHA or NKMH. The intent of this supplemental program is to provide an option for advanced skill instruction for those players aspiring to more competitive play in subsequent years. The program will begin with 3 initial evaluations sessions on Sept 7th, 14th and 21st, for the purposes selecting players ready for a higher level of skill instruction. Selection for this program will be skilled based with a limited number of positions available. Location and time of these sessions is TBD. Approximate cost for this optional program will be \$350-\$500, above and beyond basic IP player registration costs. As we are trying to gauge the level of interest for this optional skill development opportunity, we would like to hear from interested parents as soon as possible, so that we can determine whether the purchase of the necessary ice-time is financially viable.
